

Twitter Worksheet

Instructions: Complete the following tasks in class. If you have trouble with a particular step, try solving it on your own. I will be there to help you in case you get really stuck, but I would like you to try and go through this on your own. As you work, take notes on any problems you encountered along the way. Jot down how you solved them.

Follow someone		
Stop following someone		
Block and then unblock a user		
Find out if a user is following you		
Create a public list with a name and a description		
Add users to your list		
Remove users from your list		
View all tweets by members of your list		
View the profiles of the members of your list		
Find and subscribe to a list that someone else has created		
Remove yourself from the class list that I have created (corinnew/comm3309)		
View the activity (favorites, follows, list actions, etc.), not just the tweets, of everyone you follow		
Search for a hashtag (e.g., #politics)		
Identify a hashtag that is trending worldwide on Twitter		
Go to Twitterfall.com and watch the conversation on that trending hashtag		

for 2 minutes		
Identify a hashtag that is trending in Austin on Twitter		
View a user's profile information		
View a user's @-replies (other people's responses to the user)		
View a user's favorite tweets		
View a conversation among multiple users		
"Mute" a user (i.e., hide all tweets by a specific user) for a week		
Find out whether a specific tweet you sent has been retweeted or marked as a favorite by other users		
Send a direct message to a user (You must follow the user and that user must follow you, too.)		
Add your location to a tweet		
Add an image to a tweet		
Delete one of your tweets		
View your main Twitter stream alongside a stream showing search results
